JBS Hospitality Events Pty Ltd ABN 79 616 577 434 (“**Tailored Ticketing**”)

All tickets for the use of the facilities at The Event are sold by the Organiser. Only the member or event attendees and the Organiser are entering into an agreement regarding the event or membership. Tailored Ticketing acts as a sales agent and intermediary for the Organiser by order and for account of the Organiser. It is the Organisers’ duty to advise and instruct attendees/members of their eventually existing right of objection according to the legal guidelines.

Conditions of Purchase

1. All attendees at The Event who enter any ice rink contained within The Event must observe the following rules whilst on the ice:
 - a. All persons skate at their own risk;
 - b. Children under 10 years of age MUST wear a helmet (Helmets are highly recommended for all skaters);
 - c. Children under 5 years must be accompanied on the ice by an adult at all times;
 - d. Children under the age of 2 years old are not permitted on the ice under any circumstances;
 - e. Parent/ guardians are responsible for the safety of their children and must actively supervise their children at all times, and acknowledge that the staff of the Organiser cannot supervise persons (including children) who are under the supervision on others.
 - f. All patrons must wear ice skates on the ice at all times – i.e: no walking in shoes;
 - g. Please skate in anti-clockwise direction unless advised otherwise;
 - h. No Pushing;
 - i. No Speed or dangerous skating;
 - j. No carrying of children on the ice;
 - k. No chasing or playing tag on the ice;
 - l. No linking 3 or more skaters;
 - m. No throwing or spraying of ice;
 - n. No digging holes or damaging of the ice or barriers;
 - o. No sitting on the barriers;
 - p. No Bare Feet;
 - q. No Food, No Drinks, No Use of mobile phones, No Smoking, No Video Games to be used whilst on the ice;
 - r. No offensive or abusive language;
 - s. Please be courteous and respectful of all patrons and staff;
 - t. The ice surface may be uneven or wet depending on the weather, as such caution must be exercised.

- u. Patrons must obey the instructions and directions of rink and event staff
 - v. Patrons disobeying the instructions of rink & event staff and/or posted signs will be asked to leave the ice rink.
 - w. Rink and event staff will enforce the above rules for your safety and enjoyment.
 - x. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or remove guests from the ICE RINK & ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES for vandalism, stealing, offensive behaviour, queue line jumping, failure to properly supervise persons under an individual's care, failure to follow safety instructions or failure to comply with the Conditions of Entry.
 - y. The ticketholder must not be under the influence of drugs and alcohol and must not be over the legal limit of 0.05% BAC. Patrons deemed to be under the influence will not be admitted. The Organiser Staff shall have the right at anytime, to remove participants from the ICE RINK & ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES including due to inappropriate behaviour, or if under the influence of drugs or alcohol due to failure to properly supervise persons under the care of a participant.

2. the Organiser its employees and agents shall have no liability whatsoever in negligence, breach of contract or statute or statutory duty (including conditions or warranties implied by Section 74 of the Trade Practices Act 1974 or by Part 2A of the Fair Trading Act 1999 to the Customer, his/her Dependent/s or legal representative for personal injury or death suffered by the Customer arising in any way whatsoever from the supply of the activities, including but not limited to the layout, design, construction and maintenance of the ice rinks and surrounds or the presence of people or objects thereon or nearby, or any associated sporting activities or similar leisure time pursuits associated in any way with being at The Event;
3. the Customer acknowledges that the above activities are dangerous with many inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) are common and ordinary consequences and assumes and accepts all such risks and hereby waives the right to sue the Organiser for any personal injury or death in any way whatsoever arising from such activities;
- If you participate in these activities your rights to sue the Organiser under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the activities were not supplied with due care and skill or were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in or on this notice;
- the change to your rights, as set out in or on this notice, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the Organiser. Gross negligence is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004;
4. the Customer authorises the Organiser to take all steps it considers reasonably necessary to protect the Customer's welfare in the event of personal injury, including the administration of emergency first aid and medical treatment as set out on the signage displayed at The Event;

5. the Customer irrevocably consents to the Organiser photographing or filming the Customer, or any minor accompanied by the Customer, when at The Event, for use for promotional purposes, including television, film, internet and all other forms of media, recording or reproduction, without any entitlement for any compensation or financial payment;
6. Ticket are not transferable and valid only for the date/s shown. Dates can be changed online up to 48 hours prior to the session depending on availability. You can change your tickets by logging into our website, provided that you change your tickets more than 48 hours in advance of the session you have booked. Otherwise, our tickets are like those of a concert or other event and non-refundable. All ticket sales are final and we are unable to change ticket categories. Please check carefully when making your booking.
7. The Customer shall comply with all signs or other directions of the Organiser and the ticket may be suspended or cancelled and access to the ice rinks and all other facilities at The Event denied at the absolute discretion of the Organiser for non-compliance or for reckless or careless conduct.
8. Bad weather

The rink can operate in nearly all weather conditions. Please bring suitable outdoor clothing alternatively rain protection is available at the ticket office. This is an outdoor event and no refunds will be given due to inclement weather. In the unlikely event that the Duty manager deems it necessary to close the ice rink, alternative sessions will be offered for skating, subject to availability.

Entry to the event is subject to the following conditions:

1. All patrons under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Further recommended age restrictions are based on each individual screening.

Refund Policy

2. No refunds or exchanges on any ticket except as required by and/or specified by the Entertainment Industry Code of Fair Practice. Incorrect purchases are NOT guaranteed a refund and are at the discretion of the promoter.
3. The Event is a completely licensed event, so strictly NO alcohol is to be brought on site by patrons.

Delivery Instructions

4. Your ticket will be emailed to the email address specified during booking as a PDF attachment once your card has been successfully charged. you can also print your ticket at any time from the "My Account" menu. If you are unable to print your ticket(s) or do not receive your ticket(s) please bring photo ID and the credit card used to purchase the ticket to the event entry gate. The Event staff members can then look up your booking from your details.
5. At the point of entry the ticket presented must match the FULL NAME specified in the booking history and you will be asked to present a current matching driver's license, "RTA Proof of Age" card or Passport that matches this information.
6. You may either (A) nominate 1 FULL NAME for all tickets and receive ONE bar coded ticket, Everyone must arrive at once in a group. OR; (B) You may Nominate ALL attendee FULL NAMES and receive separate barcoded tickets for everyone, each person may then arrive separately. Each ticket will be emailed separately.
7. If you agree to purchase tickets under these conditions, you can then purchase up to 10 tickets using your credit card, multiple transactions by the same customer may be cancelled at the discretion of the promoter.
8. Each ticket attracts a booking fee, which are inclusive of GST. We accept MasterCard and VISA.
9. The Organiser reserves the right to withdraw, reschedule or substitute artists and/or vary advertised prices, event times and inclusions without notice. The Organiser reserves the right of admission.
10. Should the event be cancelled or rescheduled, Tailored Ticketing will contact and inform customers.
11. It is a condition of sale that tickets may not be offered for re-sale on 3rd party websites such as Ebay or Gumtree. Tickets may not be resold or offered for resale at a premium (including online auction sites) or used for advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes. If a ticket is used in breach of these conditions, it may be cancelled without refund and the bearer of the ticket may be refused admission.
12. Tickets are processed by Tailored Ticketing on behalf of the Organiser. Tailored Ticketing is in no way associated or involved in the operation of the event.
13. All tickets and products are priced in Australian dollars.

General Overview

JBS Hospitality Events Pty Ltd ABN 79 616 577 434 (Tailored Ticketing) is the operator of marketing platforms and ticketing systems for The Event. The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to disclose to you what information we may collect, how we may collect it, with whom we may share it, and certain other matters related to such information, including the choices you have regarding our collection of information and our use and disclosure to other parties of information we may have collected from you.

Tailored Ticketing is committed to protecting your privacy.

We use the information we collect about you to facilitate commercial transactions and to provide you with a more personalised experience. We have created this Privacy Policy statement in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to protecting the privacy of all of our customers and visitors. The following Privacy Statement discloses the information-gathering and dissemination practices and policies of Tailored Ticketing,

Except as otherwise discussed in this Privacy Policy, this document only addresses the use and disclosure of information we collect from you online. For some services, we either collect and transfer personal information to a service provider you have selected, or you may visit other merchants through links on our site who may collect and use your personal information. We encourage you to ask questions and to be very cautious before you disclose your personal information to others.

Types of information that may be collected

The personally identifiable information we collect is used to facilitate delivery of products and/or services to our customers. In the process of providing these products and/or services, we require our customers to provide certain personally identifiable information. Specific details may include, but is not limited to the following and may be subject to change:

* In the case of contests, promotions, and/or newsletter registrations: We require all users and/or customers wishing to participate in any of our contests, drawings, sweepstakes, promotions, or newsletters to complete a Participant Registration Form. During this registration process we generate and collect certain personally identifiable information.

* The personally identifiable information that may be collected from our customers in completion of a registration form: Customer's first name, last name, post code, phone number, age and email address. Winners of contests, drawings, sweepstakes, and/or promotions will be required to provide additional personally identifiable information such as a shipping address and telephone number.

* In the case of product and/or service purchases: In order to complete the purchase of a product and/or service, an online credit card transaction is required. During this process we generate and collect certain verifiable personally identifiable information.

* The personally identifiable information that may be collected from our customers in completion of a product and/or service purchase: The verifiable personally identifiable information required includes the customer's first and last name, customer's shipping address, phone number, and email address.

* If a customer sends us personal correspondence, such as emails or letters, we may collect such information into a file specific to you.

How is the information collected

We may collect information from you in several different areas on the Site, including but not limited to those described below:

*** Registration**

You may be asked first to complete a registration form and provide personally identifiable information; you may also be asked to choose a user ID and password in order to take advantage of certain features the Site may choose to offer, including, but not limited to, Newsletters, Contests, Forums, Fantasy or other subscription-based services.

*** Newsletters and Site Emails**

We may offer free newsletters to share information with you about the Site, about us and our affiliates and subsidiaries, or about our business partners and advertisers and sponsors. You may receive a newsletter either by registering for a particular newsletter or in conjunction with a special feature or membership for which you have registered on the Site. You may cancel your free email subscription by following the instructions provided on the Site or, in some instances, in the designated area of certain newsletters or emails.

Your personally identifiable information may be used to contact you for winner notification, prize delivery confirmation or other related purposes. We may ask your permission to allow us to post publicly some of your information on the Site, such as on a winners page, in the event you win a contest or sweepstakes. Except as required by applicable law, we will not post your information without your permission. In some instances, a third-party advertiser or sponsor may operate or host a contest or sweepstakes on the Site, and collect your information. In those cases, where we are not the operator or host of the contest or sweepstakes, we have no control over the information collected and accordingly urge you to review the advertiser's or sponsor's Privacy Policy applicable to the contest or sweepstakes before participating.

*** Surveys or Voting**

From time-to-time we may request personally identifiable information from you via surveys or voting polls. Participation is voluntary and you will have the opportunity to decide whether or not to disclose information. At times, you may have to register to vote or to take part in a survey.

*** Cookies**

As with many Websites, the Site uses standard technology called "cookies," which are small data files that are transferred to your computer when you allow your browser to accept cookies. Cookies automatically identify your Web browser to the Site whenever you visit the Site, and make using the Site easier for you by saving your passwords, purchases, and preferences. By tracking how and when you use the Site, cookies help us determine which areas are popular and which are not. Many improvements and updates to the Site are based on data obtained from cookies. Accepting cookies allows you, among other things, to personalize your experience on the Site. Cookies may also allow the Site to present to you advertising which may be of interest to you. If you do not want information collected through the use of cookies, you generally can opt out of providing this information by turning the cookies off in your browser; however, some areas of the Site may not provide you with a personalized experience if you have disabled the use of cookies.

*** IP Addresses and Click-stream Data**

We may collect IP addresses and/or click-stream data for purposes of system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers and sponsors. An IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer whenever you access the Internet. Our computers identify your computer by its IP address. When you request Web pages from the Site, our computers log your IP address. Click-stream data is information collected by our computers when you request Web pages from the Site. Click-stream data may include such information as the page served, the time, the source of the request, the type of browser making the request, the preceding page view and

other such non-personal information. When analysed, this data helps us analyse how visitors arrive at the Site, what type of content is most popular, what type of visitors in the aggregate are interested in particular kinds of content and advertising, and the like.

*** Transaction Information**

If you order any information from our Site, buy any of our products or subscribe for any of the services offered on our Site, we will ask you to complete an order form that will request certain information from you, including financial information such as a credit card number and expiration date and general contact, billing and shipping information. We will use this information to complete the transaction that you have requested, i.e., to deliver the information, products or other services that you order, and to invoice you. Such information is collected and stored through encrypted means for your protection.

How we use the information we collect

We internally use personally identifiable information about our customers to improve our marketing and promotional efforts, to statistically analyse site usage, to improve our content and product offerings and to customize our site's content and layout. We believe these uses allow us to improve our site and provide better service to our customers.

We may occasionally use a customer's email address and, in rare situations mailing address or phone number, to contact a customer regarding administrative matters or notices.

We may use information in the file we maintain about a customer to resolve disputes and troubleshoot problems.

With whom the information may be shared

Information we collect may be accessed by a variety of parties, depending upon the project for which the information was originally collected, the terms of that engagement, and the policies into or out of which the consumer has opted. From time to time, we may send you offers from Tailored Ticketing, its affiliated properties, and our promotional partners based on the information you have provided us. In addition, we may provide information we collect about you with third party companies regarding promotions, sweepstakes and other opportunities / offers. These third parties are subject to stringent data security and confidentiality requirements.

While we believe this disclosure of your information will result in opportunities that may be of interest to you, you have the right to tell us not to give your information to any third party. If you

Your request must include your name, email address, mailing address. Please allow six weeks to process your request. After your request has been fulfilled, the only disclosures we will make are those required by law.

What choices do I have about Tailored Ticketing collecting, using, and sharing my information

It is possible for you to use much of our site without giving us any personally identifiable information. When you do register with us or give us personally identifiable information, you will have an opportunity at the time we collect your information -- to limit e-mail communications from Tailored Ticketing and from our third-party partners. You can request at any time that Tailored Ticketing not send future e-mail to you either by unsubscribing from the communication or by contacting us at info@tailoredticketing.com. Also, as mentioned above, there are ways to limit the information collected through technology -- though some of our features won't work if you decide to do this.

What security precautions are in place to protect against the loss, misuse, or alteration of your information

Chat Rooms, Forums, and Message Boards
